I am thankful for having planes and boats to help us get from island to island.



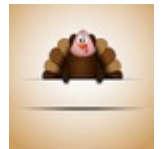

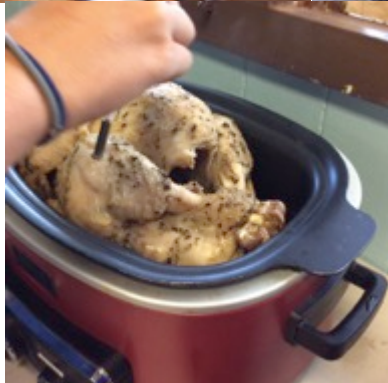
